The first European Protocol Development Committee (EPDC) Meeting will be held on *Saturday, October 10th* in Milan, Italy. All CyberKnife Society members are eligible to attend this meeting, but for the launch of this initial EPDC, *attendance will be open to all European CyberKnife users.*

This committee brings together clinician users working together to define CyberKnife practice guidelines and research proposals. The goal of this forum is to work individually and/or collaboratively to publish clinical papers that will ultimately increase treatment options for patients throughout the body.
